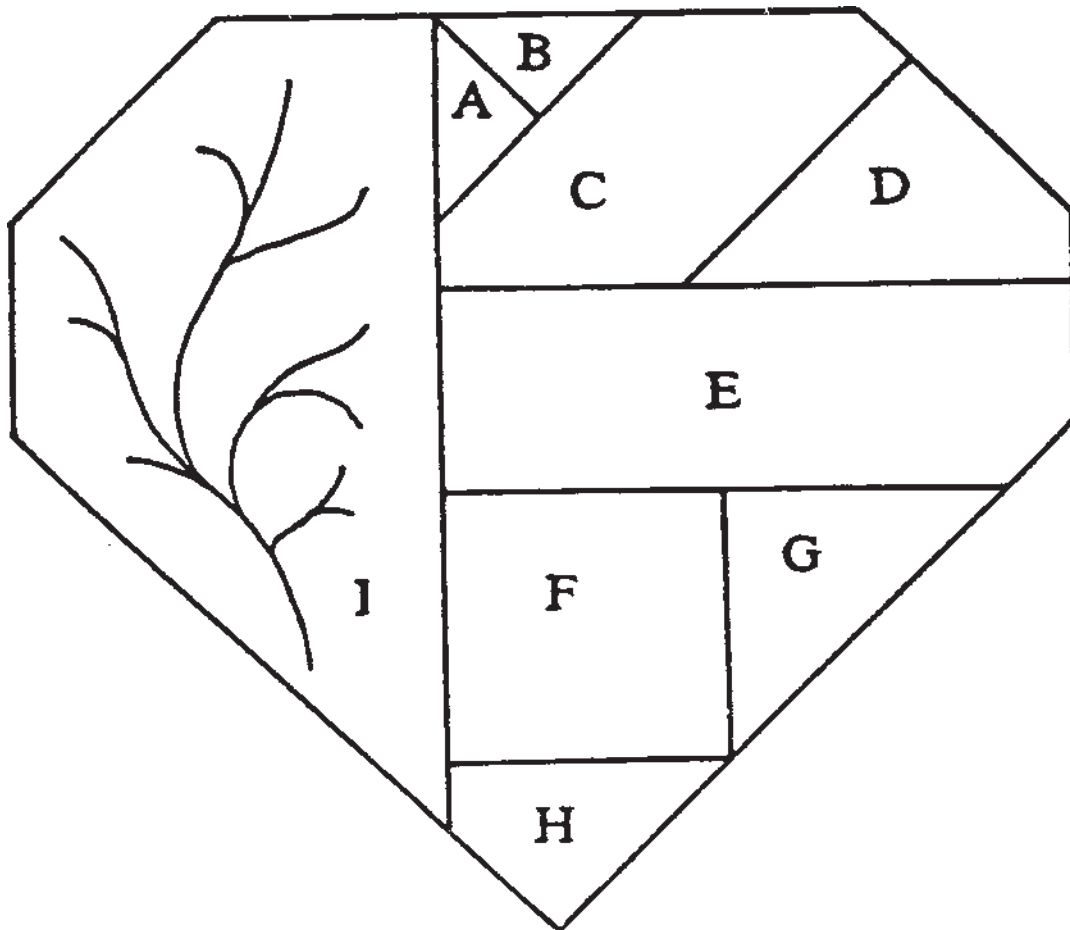


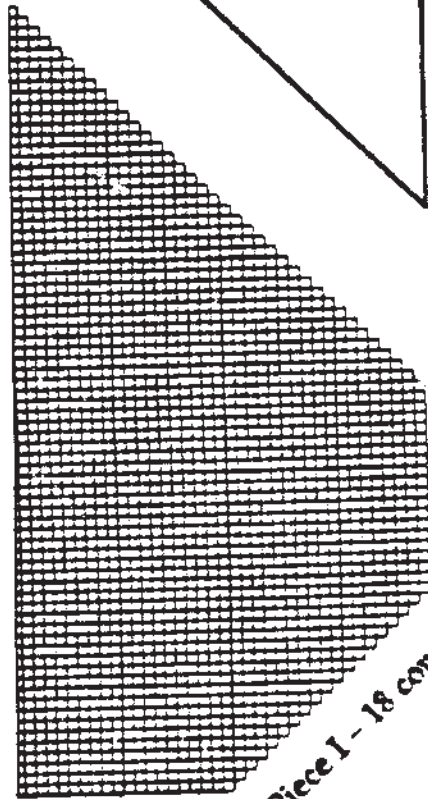
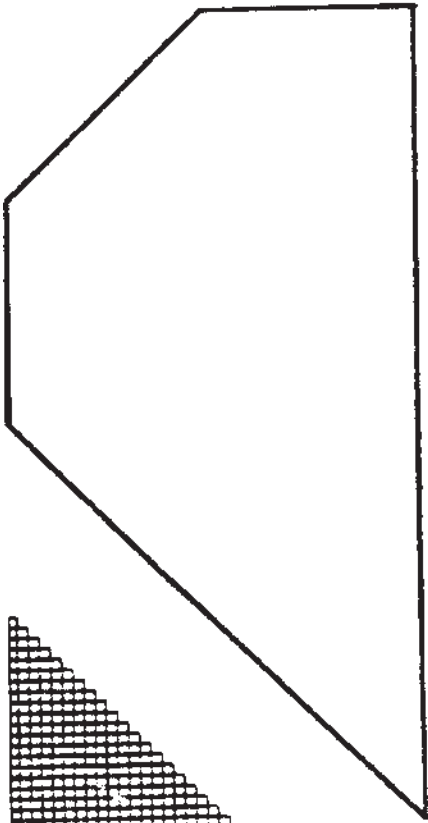
CABIN BRANCH QUILTERS
NAME TAG PATTERN

You may embellish and embroider your badges any way you wish. To help you, there are doodling and charting spaces on the following page. To encourage everybody to make and wear their badges, the club has established that members will pay a 25¢ fine each time they come to a meeting without wearing their badges.

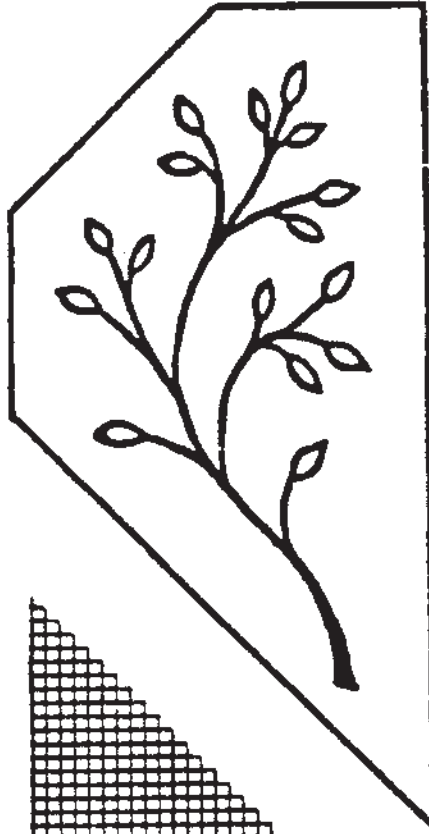
DIRECTIONS

1. Read all directions before starting, especially the hints at the end of #5. **Note:** All fabric pieces will need to have a $\frac{1}{4}$ " seam allowance added. Note also that piece B is optional. You can make your tag a true heart shape by leaving out piece B.
2. Cut out the heart pattern as a single piece. glue it onto a cardboard backing such as a manila file folder. Cut one entire heart out of your backing material, adding a $\frac{1}{4}$ " seam allowance all around. Cut another entire heart out of thin batting. Put both pieces aside for use later.
3. Cut the heart pattern apart into pieces A, B, C, D, E, F, G, H, and I. Trace onto fabric, making sure that pieces B and E are out of light color (your name goes on piece E). **Important:** Add $\frac{1}{4}$ " seam allowance to all pieces and make sure piece C is placed correctly and has not been flipped over.
4. Sew pieces A and B together. Sew AB unit to C, now add D. Sew unit ABCD to E. Sew H to F. Add G to unit HF. Add ABCDE unit. Add piece I.
5. Embroider branch onto piece I, embellishing with buds, leaves or flowers. Write or embroider you name on piece E. **Hint:** You may want to embroider pieces E and I before cutting them out, as it is easier to embroider on a large piece of fabric. To do this, lightly trace the pattern piece in the right side of you chosen fabric, then embroider it. Check your piece to make sure the embroidery hasn't distorted the fabric, then retrace the piece.
6. Layer batting, backing and top, right sides together, and sew around the edge, leaving an opening to tum. Turn inside out, whip stitch closed, and attach a large safety pin to the back.

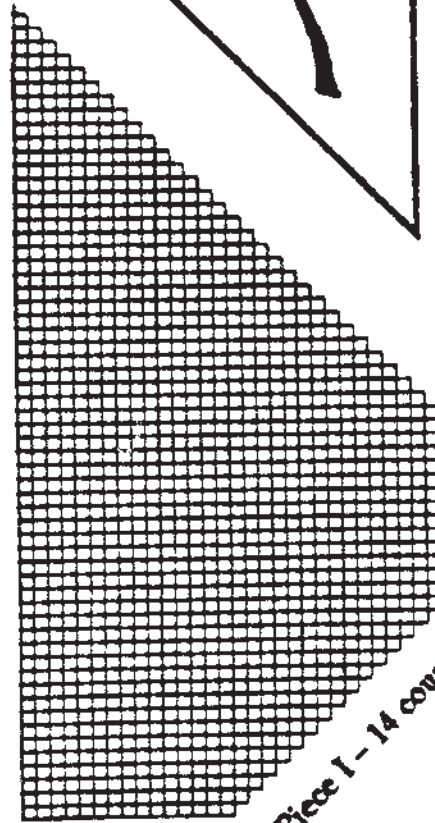




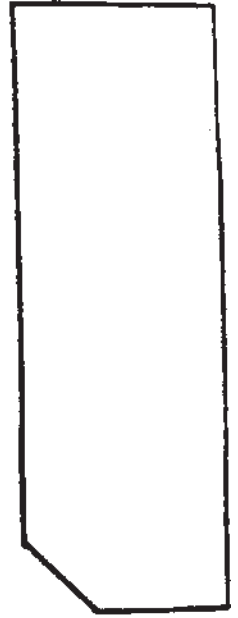
Piece I - 18 count



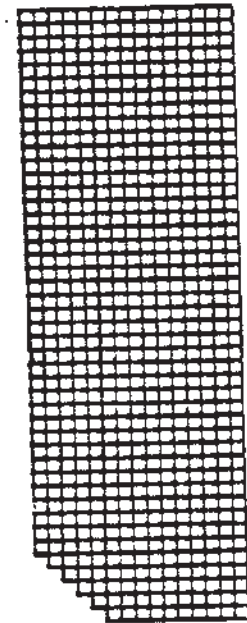
Branch design as it appears on our club pin.
